What are hours with faculty?

Studio Practice Hours

ART 669X, 779X, 889X, or ART 6008

Studio hours is the same concept as an independent study course. You are essentially signing up for independent study hours with a specific faculty member. You are expected to create work that this faculty member can give you feedback for.

The number of credit hours you sign up for will determine how many meetings you have with your faculty member.

Number of credit hours taken with a faculty member	Number of required meetings (14 week semester)
1	2-3
2	4-5
3	6+

How do I enroll/register for a studio practice hours course?

To enroll in studio hours with a faculty member, you must reach out to them, and ask them the following questions.

- Can I take hours with you?

If yes,

- How many credit hours may I sign up for?
 - What is your course number that I can register with?

What faculty am I allowed to register for studio practice hours with?

- a) Any regular, tenured and tenure track graduate faculty members within the Department of Art. This includes faculty within a student's major area and external to the area.
- b) Auxiliary Art department faculty with adjunct or visiting titles such as professor, associate professor, assistant professor, or senior lecturer.
- c) More than one faculty member per semester.
- d) Graduate students needing credit hours in their major studio area and wishing to take those with faculty not assigned to that area must get approval from their major area coordinator. (e.g. a Printmaking area student needs major studio hours and wants to take them with a Photo

area faculty member. The student must obtain permission from the Printmaking area coordinator.) The applicable area course fee will be charged.

e) Graduate students wishing coursework instruction in a medium outside their major area must receive permission to attend class from the faculty member in charge of the course and take area studio practice hours with them. Students will be charged the applicable area course fee.

f) Graduate students may not register for studio practice hours with lecturers.

How many faculty should I take hours with per semester?

Graduate students are strongly advised to take hours with 3 or 4 faculty per semester. However, with the approval of the Major Advisor, students may take hours with more faculty.

More tips

To find what faculty belong to what areas you may go to the Art Department website, and click on the People tab.

You can also filter by faculty, and then by area. “Departmental” faculty are auxiliary/unaffiliated faculty.
